Toastmasters Clubs use many acronyms. Here are some common acronyms you might hear during a meeting:

CC = Competent Communicator (Formerly known as CTM, an individual who has complete the 10 speeches in the Competent Communicator's Manual)

CL = Competent Leader (Individual who has achieved CTM or CC and has completed the Competent Leader's Manual)

CTM = Competent Toastmaster (Individual who has complete the 10 speeches in the Basic Communication and Leadership Manual)

DTM = Distinguished Toastmaster (Individual who has achieved both ATM-G and AL distinctions)

VPE = Vice President of Education

VPM = Vice President of Membership
